Smartphones

Tablets are becoming more and more popular among nurses and physicians. 62% of physicians are now using tablets, with over half of them being used at point-of-care.

of nurses are now using smartphones in their daily jobs.



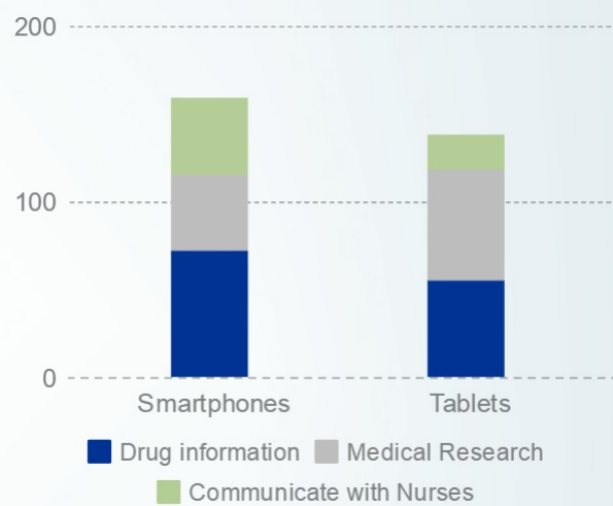
Access to Info

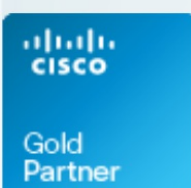
